# Call 2011 – organised in two parts

## 1. Valorisation of federal administrative records

- *One single project* : FPS Social Security – modeling EU2020 social inclusion indicators in the context of demographic changes (migration) – 300,000€ (70,000€ cofunded by Social Security)

## 2. Valorisation of collections held by the FSI's

- *Open call for proposals* for a budget of 1,85 million €

# PART 1

## One thematic priority

- *FPS Social Security : Development of a model for prospective data with respect to poverty and social inclusion indicators in the frame of the EU-2020 strategy, with a focus on the impact of migration*

The maximum allocated budget for the project that will be selected in this theme is 300.000€, of which 70.000€ based on a funding by the FPS Social Security. Interested team will read the full description of this theme in the information file.

# PART 1

## Timing

- **14 September 3 PM** : Full proposal (English) and synthetic form (language of the institution of the coordinator)
- **15 sept. – mid- Oct.** : Evaluation of proposals by scientific peers and advice of the programme committee
- **Mid-November** : Approval by Council of Ministers of budgets expenses for selected research proposal
- **End November – mid December** : Contract
- **1 februari 2012** : Beginning of the project

# PART 1

## Proposals should address:

- *The thematic priority in a comprehensive way*
- *Multidisciplinarity*
- *International dimension*
- *Geographical dimension*
- *Gender dimension*

*Evaluation will be based on scientific quality of the proposals and the above mentioned criteria*

- *Support to the decision making, in particular the General Cell Drugs Policy, but also the field, relevant intermediate organisations and target groups*

Advice of the Programme committee will be based exclusively on this aspect

# PART 2

No thematic priority!

A budget of 1,85 mio € shall be allocated to fund on average two proposals per pôle (150,000/230,000€ per proposal)

# PART 2

## Timing:

- **19 September 3 PM** : Mark of Interest (for evaluation purposes)
- **10 October 3 PM**: Full proposal (English)
- **Mid October– end November** : Evaluation of proposals by scientific peers and advice of the Cell RSI
- **Mid-December** : Approval by Council of Ministers of budgets expenses for selected research proposals
- **January/February** : Contracts (Royal Decrees)
- **April 2012** : Beginning of the projects

# PART 2

## Proposals should address:

- a **collection** (or set of collections) of an FSI
- **scientific activities** associated to the acquisition – conservation – restoration - valorisation of a collection with the objective to enable (better) scientific reuse
- Scientific activities should be **upstream** of scientific exploitation (remains possible if small scale e.g. for testing)
- **Sustainability** of the outcome of the project (implication of the FSI)
- **International** dimension

*Evaluation will be based on scientific quality of the proposals and the above mentioned criteria*
