Conference "Reimaging Peace"

- Flemish Parliament, 8-9 May 2023
- Flemish Peace Institute, in cooperation with
 - Tampere Peace Research Institute (Finland)
 - Peace Research Center Prague (Czech Republic)
 - Peace Research Center Oslo (Norway)
 - Post-Conflict Research Center Sarajevo (Bosnia)
- Approx 125 participants
- Programme:
 - Thematic break-out groups
 - Keynote speech
 - Interactive panel discussions
 - Next Generation Peace Research
- → follow-up online discussions with original partners

Cost Action proposal

- Choice for COST Action
 - Best suited, but some important challenges
- > Joint effort but with core group leading
 - Main proposer from FPI + 15 secondary proposals from 10 countries
- → Very good evaluation (46/50)

- > Summer School
- Communication & outreach, including:
 - Webinars
 - Mapping of peace research in Europe
- → Already over 280 members
- → Kick-Off Conference (8 May 2025) and General Meeting (9 May)

Tips and tricks for preparation

> In addition to the 'typical tips' for project proposals:

- Have a good starting base
 - Broad network of secondary proposers
- Interdisciplinary and innovative approach
- Do not duplicate existing initiatives
- Be ambitious, but realistic
- Emphasize diversity
- Include next-generation initiatives
- Make agreements in advance on leadership positions

Challenges in implementation

- "Open" network
 - Limited resources
 - Composition and expectations of Management Committee
 - Overrepresentation of participants from a few countries
- > Too much rules & procedures
- No funding for time
