Organisation of IAP-Meetings

(Bi-)Annual meetings with all the partners and researchers of the network organised by the coordinator

WP meetings organised by the WP-leaders

Informal meetings, brain storming meetings on specific topics,

Stimulating joint research activities and exchanges

Catalyst activities visit to the labs to spot the meaningful opportunities for collaboration

Scientific visits: to exchange scientific knowledge, ...

Research stays of staff members (PhD students, postdocs) : _to learn techniques, to perform experiments,

Exchange of personnel (short and long stays)

Exchange of material, tools, data, technical aspects and methods, expertise ...

Common use of equipment, databases, ...

Co-supervision of PhD thesis, presence of at least two members of the network in the PhD jury, ...

<u>Organisation and co-organisation of seminars, workshops, short courses, conferences, symposia</u> (organised by one partner or more partners of the network)

Seminars organised by the different partners (with invitations to all members of the network)

Training courses / Workshops on specific topics of the IAP-network: organised by one or more IUAP-partners (only for IAP or open for external researchers with reduced fee for IAP-members)

Graduate/ Doctoral school in the framework of the IAP

Organisation of national and international symposia by one or more partners of the network to present the work of the IAP to the scientific community.

Organisation of an international IAP-symposium with ALL the partners of the network to disseminate the results of the IAP network to the international community.
