

**Visual Identity Guidelines** 

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The following pages contain more explanation and visualisation on how to use the **Federescue** identity. The aim of this guide is to help you understand how to use and apply the logo & identity to any materials you might produce.

## Logo

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Logo

The **full colour logo** is the preferred logo version. The logo must be used as provided with the belgian flag and cannot be altered in any way.



A monochrome version of the logo can be used for **printed materials** with color restriction.



The space around the logo has been established to ensure visibility and impact. Maintaining the **clear space zone between the logo and other graphic elements** ensures that the logo always appears unobstructed and distinctly separate from any other graphic elements. The clear space is based on the **width of the letter F** as identified here.

The logo can be used on a photo background. Always use the white logo on a dark background.








Don't change the colors of the logo even if they are similar. Don't resize the logo out of proportions. Don't alter the logo by changing the font or swash. Always make sure the logo is legible by size or by contrast.



Applied consistently, colours provide a strong visual link across various materials and communications. It is important that only the colours illustrated are used.

The colours are specified for print (CMYK) and use on screenand web (RGB and Hexadecimal).



Additional colours can be used for graphs, visuals and punctual elements.




/ Use of colour

The black, yellow and red should be used **together** on a document. Avoid using only red and yellow, black and yellow or black and red.

When working with typography it is important to look for a **strong contrast** between the background colour and the text.

Using a light background with a similar colour for the text will result in poor legibility, the same applies for a dark background and dark text.

The minimal use of colour is often the most effective graphically. Using the preselected colours will provide a wide range of design options whilst adhering to our core identity.



## Manrope by Mikhail Sharanda is the primary typeface.
