<p><u>Overview of the field of activity proposed:</u></p> <p>Under the authority of the Secretary General, the trainee will contribute to and/or perform under their own responsibility, the following duties:</p> <p>Project administration: end-to-end administration of projects which may entail organising events, meetings, gatherings, ceremonies, match-making opportunities, publications and any other activities necessary for Eurisy to fulfill its objectives;</p> <p>Partnership development: to contribute to identifying potential partners for Eurisy from the space and non-space sectors to jointly carry out activities aimed at promoting satellite applications and, more generally, the benefits of space in those sectors;</p> <p>Knowledge production: In the framework of the projects assigned to them, or collaboratively with the team, the trainee will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • identify and document examples of public or private entities using satellite services; • gather information on the activities and priorities of Eurisy's Members, especially in relation related to Eurisy's own activities; • research trends in the space sector in terms of new technological developments, new products and services • document non-technical factors that influence the adoption of satellite services; • collect user needs and study trends in various sectors, public or private, where space provides an added value. <p>Communication: to contribute to the communication of Eurisy's activities to different audiences, including user communities, service providers, the space sector and policy makers.</p>
